Academic and industry studies show that SMEs have historically faced higher financing hurdles than large companies. Because SMEs tend to have greater volatility in both earnings and growth than larger companies, SMEs are viewed as riskier investments, and thus subject to higher debt and equity costs. In addition, SMEs have limited management time and ability to develop relationships with lenders and investors, or to expand the number of such relationships.

Improving access to affordable working capital will allow SMEs to have the confidence to bid on larger contracts, hire staff, contribute to their communities, and improve their credit ratings, all of which will lead to greater scale, capacity and success.
