Prior to MUFG Union Bank, Glenn led a team of senior product managers at BB&T responsible for e-commerce and commercial channels, maintaining and replacing the commercial online / mobile banking solution, the development of a SSO commercial portal and dashboard, data security, systems authentication, malware detection, Information Reporting, Escrow Services, ZBA and Sweeps. The team also had ownership of connectivity (host to host) based services.

In a Senior Technical Product Consulting role at both BB&T (2012 – 2018) and Bank of America (1998 – 2012), Glenn supported treasury relationship managers as a treasury subject matter expert for treasury serving Commercial, Middle Market and Large Corporate / Capital Markets clients in complex engagements.

While at Bank of America, Glenn worked on the team to generate and send the first ever Image Cash Letter as a part of Check 21 (Bank of America to Wachovia). He also has over 30 years serving in different roles within the financial services industry and over 10 years of prior experience leading teams.

Glenn also has expertise aligned with many industry verticals such as real estate, service organizations, retail, energy, general industries, financial services providers (banks and nonbanks) and the healthcare industry. Glenn evolved the initial healthcare revenue cycle management services at BB&T and served as the enterprise subject matter expert for payments, revenue cycle management, and general industry expertise.

Glenn has also presented at regional AFP conferences in Tampa, FL (TBAFP), Atlanta, GA, Richmond, VA (CAFP), and Baltimore, MD (MAAFP), presented at seminars on topics such as CyberFraud, Cash Flow and Working Capital Management: Executing a Payments Paper to Electronic Strategy, Real-Time Payments, The Evolution of Banking from AI to Zelle, etc. and has published a white paper called "Using Your Cash to Fuel Business Growth".
